

MODULES

SPIRITUAL FORMATION

APR-JUN | 20 CREDITS

Theology is not only an academic discipline, it is practical. For a Christian, theology is practised daily, not only through our words but by our conduct. This module will explore the practices which enhance and bring value to our understanding of God and our relationship with the divine.

CULTIVATING A HEALTHY CULTURE

In an ever changing world the Church continues to proclaim a message of truth, hope, love, and peace. How we facilitate our churches is always changing but the necessity of integrity and faith does not. In this module students will be equipped with a better understanding of the practical knowledge and tools they will need for the efficient and effective running of a ministry and/or church as an organisation.

FOUNDATIONS OF FAITH

SEPT-DEC | 20 CREDITS

This course provides an overview of key Christian doctrines within an orthodox, evangelical theological worldview. These doctrines lay the foundation of our faith and provide a solid grounding in biblical Christianity, equipping students to engage with a world full of curiosity and questions about our faith. Sessions include the Doctrine of the Trinity, Christology, ecclesiology, eschatology and more!

CHRISTIAN LEADERSHIP FOR TODAY'S CHURCH SEPT-DEC | 20 CREDITS

Christian leadership is based on the principles of the kingdom of God revealed in scripture and requires humility, integrity and faithfulness. This course will equip students to develop a better understanding of leadership in a Christian context, considering not only personal development but also the establishment and continual development of a culture which is naturally formed by leaders.

Sessions will include leadership case studies, personal development, theology of power and the marks of biblical leadership.

BIBLICAL STUDY SKILLS

JAN-APR | 20 CREDITS

Scripture is the inspired word of God and was written by particular authors, in a particular time, for particular purposes. In studying scripture we seek to understand what it says about itself, and this course will equip you with the tools to faithfully interpret biblical texts for study, preaching, teaching and more.

Sessions include textual interpretation, exegetical practices, literary criticism and Old & New Testament cultural contexts.

MINISTRY TRAINING

Ministry training is a deeply practical element of the course, available for full time students. Students will train within a department alongside a member of Life Church staff, giving you an invaluable opportunity to develop the skills you need for ministry.

STUDENT EXPERIENCE

Community

Community is a huge part of the student experience at LCC! We have a diverse student body with many international students joining us each year, so we value learning about one another's culture and background. Students also have many opportunities to serve the city of Bradford together through our church outreach and evangelism programs.

Church Life

COURSE FEES

Full Time: £ 2400 p/a.

Part Time course: £ 220 each.

What's included?

Full time

Apart from the teaching content, every student has access to pastoral care through our church pastoral team, as well as opportunities to join discussion groups facilitated by lecturers and tutors. All students will also be given access to the online library *Perlego* to help with the cost of textbooks and computers to complete assignments.

Part Time Courses

Fees include teaching content, student support and enrollment on Moodle - our online student portal.

Online provision is available on request.

Installments

We have worked hard to keep our course fees as low as possible, and in the current economic climate we understand that students may find it difficult to pay in full. Therefore, students can opt to pay fees in monthly installments. This can be organised directly with the College team.



Are the modules credit bearing?

Yes! We have modules approved through Wrexham Glyndwr University. These modules are 20 credits each at level 4. When you pass and complete the requisite modules you will receive a Certificate of credit from the University.

Will I be able to get a student loan to help me with my fees?

LIFE Church College students are currently unable to access government student loans, however the LIFE Church College is registered with an organisation called Stewardship. Through our link with Stewardship it is possible for students to receive an extra 22% of funds donated to them if they are given through Stewardship. So a gift of £1000 can become a gift of £1220 through their help. This money can be used to pay tuition fees, but students can also use it to support their day-to-day living costs such as rent or food bills.

What age are students?

All students must be over the age of 18 to study at LCC. We have no upper age limit, as we believe everyone can and should grow in theology and leadership. However, the majority of our full time students are between 18 and 35.
